

(Infants—3 years old):

Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of the month We welcome Adult members into full communion through (Exception: There are no Baptisms in December or March). the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. We welcome all who worship with us who are not baptized or were baptized Please register your child at least one month in advance by in a different Christian tradition to join us as full members coming to the rectory. You must complete the registration of the Catholic Christian Community through the form and submit the child's birth certificate. In addition, Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Please parents and Godparents MUST attend preparation class speak with Dr. Marva Chevalier for more information. We PRIOR to Baptism. also welcome baptized Catholics who have not been confirmed or received the Eucharist.
